Proposal

Financials

- Based on the above assumptions, the total amount donated (including annual contributions and compound interest) over the 10 years will be approximately \$1.3million.
- Therefore, on an individual donor basis, \$6,667 in donations (\$10,000 less 33% refund) over ten years will equate to \$13,206 in funding for the Takapuna Rugby Club.
